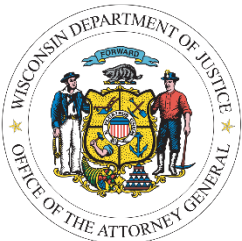

## **ACRONYMS & KEY TERMS**

**GJJC** = Governor's Juvenile Justice Commission. A group of juvenile justice system professionals, youth organization representatives, and young people who work together to fund youth programs and influence state policy.

**JJDPA** = Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act. A federal law that sets standards for how youth must be treated in the state juvenile justice system. It required that each state have a State Advisory Group with youth members and provides funding to states for delinquency prevention and intervention.

**SAG** = State Advisory Group. A group required by the JJDPA to set funding priorities and influence state juvenile justice policy. The GJJC is Wisconsin's SAG.
