Welcome and Call Meeting to Order

Chair Sharlen Moore welcomed commissioners to the meeting.

Subcommittee Sharing

<u>Policy, Legislation and Compliance (PLC) Subcommittee</u> – Commissioner Carl Ashley reported that the DOJ Staff distributed the GJJC memo supporting Assembly Bill 48 and Senate Bill 55 to the legislature and the Governor. The bills relate to prosecuting or adjudicating delinquent a

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person under the age of 18 for committing an act of prostitution. This legislation, also known as Safe Harbor legislation, is primarily designed to steer young victims of commercial sexual exploitation and sex trafficking away from delinquency or criminal justice system involvement.

Commissioner Ashley reported the subcommittee cancelled the June meeting and the next meeting is September 26, 2023.

<u>Ethnic and Racial Disparities (ERD) Subcommittee</u> – Commissioner Moore reported the ERD Subcommittee has discussed research regarding School Resource Officers (SROs) and the pending legislation that would create state training of SROs.

Commissioner Moore reported the next meeting is September 13, 2023.

<u>Youth Voice Commission (YVC)</u> – Kiley Komro reported the YVC has been meeting on the last Wednesday of every month. Eight youth participated in the last meeting. Komro highlighted the previous topics discussed at the meetings and announced the topics for the future meetings, including a presentation by Commissioner Gonring on youth rights in court.

Wisconsin Department of Justice (DOJ) Updates

<u>Staff Update</u> – Matt Allord reported La Trisha Quade has been hired as the Title II Federal Grant Specialist. La Trisha will also work on the Youth Gang and Elder Abuse Prevention programs.

<u>JJDPA Compliance</u> – Allord reported DOJ Staff has finalized the compliance data for the 2023 report. Allord prepared a summary of the data and reported Wisconsin is in compliance with the core requirements and expects to receive to full funding. Allord went through each section of the summary and answered questions from the Commission.

<u>Conferences and Presentations</u> – Allord reported that he was a workshop presenter at the Juvenile Courts Clerks Conference on July 27, and will be a workshop presenter on the JJDPA at the WI Courts – Juvenile Justice Seminar on August 17, 2023.

Allord reported Kiley Komro attended the Coalition for Juvenile Justice Youth Summit in Tacoma, Washington from July 31- August 1.

<u>Grants Update</u> – Komro reported she will be reviewing subgrant applications for the compliance grant.
